I understand the term financial aid includes state and federal funds including but not limited to: Monetary Award Program (MAP), Pell, SEOG, IIA, student loans, military benefits, and scholarships.

If my financial aid does not completely cover my tuition bill or I am ineligible for financial aid, I am responsible for making payment immediately to the Business Office.

I realize that until all requested information has been submitted, reviewed, and verified, financial aid will not be credited to my student account, and I will not be allowed a book voucher, if eligible.

I have reviewed the Standards of Progress, and I understand I must meet **all** of the guidelines to continue receiving financial aid. Including completion of 67% of my attempted course load and maintaining a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.0 each semester I attend PSC even if Financial Aid did not cover my expenses.

I understand I can not owe a repayment on any federal or state student financial aid program or be in **default** on a student loan and receive financial aid.

I understand **that not all classes or programs** are eligible for financial aid, including student loans. Even if eligible for financial aid, these courses/programs will not be paid with these funds.

I must reapply for financial aid each year, and I can not receive financial aid from two schools during the same semester.

I understand I am responsible for dropping my classes if I choose not to attend the college.

If at any time enrollment drops below 6 credit hours, the Federal Student Loan is canceled as well as any remaining disbursements. The student will be responsible for any remaining balance.

If I completely withdraw from school or reported as not attending in my courses, I may be required to repay a portion or all of my Financial Aid.

I understand that my college's financial aid office may request additional documentation to complete my financial aid award.

Veterans Only: For Montgomery GIBILL purposes, I understand I **must** submit all previous transcripts to the Enrollment Office for review. Failure to do so in a timely manner can result in postponed educational payments by the Department of Veteran Affairs (VA).

Veterans Only: I understand that each semester I must submit a rights and responsibility form with a copy of my final class schedule. Any time I change my class schedule, I must immediately submit a copy of my revised schedule to my veteran advisor.

Post 9/11 Only: According to Federal Regulations Authority: 38 U.S.C. 3034(a), 3323(a), 3680(d), 3680(e). In the first instance of a withdrawal from a course or courses for which the eligible individual received educational assistance, VA will consider mitigating circumstances to exist with respect to the withdrawal of a course or courses totaling no more than six semester hours or the equivalent. In determining whether a withdrawal is the first instance of withdrawal, VA will not consider a course or courses dropped during an institution of higher learning's drop-add period in accordance with §21.4200(1). If mitigating circumstances are considered to exist in accordance with this paragraph, VA will terminate or reduce educational assistance effective the end of the month during which the withdrawal occurred.

Post 9/11 Only: (Authority: 38 U.S.C. 3034(a), 3323(a), 3680(a)(1). Withdrawal or unsatisfactory completion of all courses. (1) If the eligible individual, for reasons other than being called or ordered to active duty service, withdraws from all courses or receives all non-punitive grades and, in either case, there are no mitigating circumstances, VA will terminate educational assistance effective the first date of the term in which the withdrawal occurs or the first date of the term for which non-punitive grades are assigned.

Post 9/11 Only: (Authority: 38 U.S.C. 3323, 3680(a)). (d)Reduction in the rate of pursuit of a program of education. If the eligible individual reduces the rate of pursuit by withdrawing from one or more courses in a program of education but continues training in one or more courses, VA will apply the provisions of this paragraph.

(1) If the reduction in the rate of pursuit occurs other than on the first date of the term, VA will reduce the eligible individual's educational assistance effective the end of the month during which the reduction occurred when the circumstances in either paragraphs (d)(1)(i) or (d)(1)(ii) apply--

(i) A nonpunitive grade is assigned for the course from which the eligible individual withdraws and the withdrawal occurs with mitigating circumstances.

(ii) A punitive grade is assigned for the course from which the eligible individual withdraws.

(2) VA will reduce educational assistance effective the first date of the enrollment in which the reduction occurs when--

(i) The reduction occurs on the first date of the term; or

(ii) A nonpunitive grade is assigned for the course from which the eligible individual withdraws, and--

(a.) The eligible individual does not withdraw because he or she is called to active duty service, or in the case of an individual serving on active duty, he or she is not ordered to a new duty location or assignment, or is not ordered to perform an increased amount of work, and

(b.) The withdrawal occurs without mitigating circumstances.
