



High School Seniors Tuition FREE Class Process

Students must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- High school student must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
 - Attend a high school in Prairie State College's district or live in-district and attend a high school elsewhere.
 - Course must be taken the summer before senior year or during the fall or spring semester of senior year. **Please Note:** Students who have attempted, but not completed senior year, who have graduated or whose high school class has graduated or its equivalent are ineligible.
 - Course must be taken **and** completed before high school graduation.

Complete the PSC "High School Senior FREE Class Application" form.

- High school counselor must indicate which course is recommended for completion at Prairie State College.
- The form must be signed by a high school counselor/administrator and by a Prairie State College counselor or advisor.
- The high school seal must be affixed to the completed form.
- Official high school transcript (in sealed envelope) required.

Complete the PSC Admissions Application.

- Bring completed Admissions Application along with the completed High School FREE Class Application and high school transcript to the Prairie State College Counseling and Advising Center, located next to the Library.

Students must take the college placement (COMPASS) test and meet all course prerequisites before enrolling in classes. Please note: ACT scores may be used in place of COMPASS. An ACT score of 22+ in reading **and** a 17+ in English places a student directly into English 101. An ACT reading score of 22+ exempts a student from having to take the COMPASS reading test. Math ACT placement is determined by a student's academic program. Students should meet with an academic advisor for further information.

- Refer to COMPASS Assessment Test handout for information and test dates.
 - COMPASS scores are available within a few days after test completion.
 - All high school students are required to meet with a PSC counselor or advisor for assistance with the registration process.
