- Students must take the college placement (COMPASS) test or provide ACT scores and meet all course prerequisites before enrolling in classes. **Official high school transcript required.**
- Students currently enrolled in high school are not eligible to receive federal financial aid funds.
- **Students are responsible for the payment of fees, books, and related supplies.**
- Students will earn college and/or institutional college credit for these courses.
- If course grade(s) information is to be reported to the high school, the student will need to complete a "Transcript Request Form." The completed form must be returned to the Office of Admissions (Room 1160). A fee of \$2 is assessed for each transcript requested.
- Prairie State College cannot guarantee the availability of courses selected.

Tuition Waiver Eligibility Requirements and Information

- Students may be eligible for one free credit course (up to 6 semester credits). **NOTE:** EMS 101, Nursing 100 and all Internet courses are not eligible for this opportunity.
- Student is a high school senior who lives in PSC district or attends a high school in PSC district, or lives in-district and attends a high school elsewhere.
- **The free class must be taken either the summer before senior year or during senior year (fall or spring semester) of high school. The course must be completed prior to the student's high school graduation.**
- High School Counselor/Administrator must certify that the student currently has a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. GPA is equivalent to a "B-/C+" grade average.
- Students may be eligible for a second free credit course (up to 6 semester credits). The course is available to students who earned a grade of "B" or better in their first free PSC course. This course must be completed prior to high school graduation.
