Prairie State College offers Music 100 – Fundamentals of Music Theory

This three credit hour course introduces the basic principles of interpreting and understanding the language of music. It includes the study of notation, rhythm, scales, intervals, basic forms, musical terms, and introduction to the keyboard.

High School Students – Opportunity for a free class

High school students, age 16 and older (with permission), who are interested in pursuing music are encouraged to take this music theory course.

Students in the Class of 2012 may take one college–credit class at PSC with no charge for tuition.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must attend a high school in the PSC district in Illinois
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4-point scale
- Have permission from an appropriate school authority
- Take the PSC COMPASS placement test or submit ACT scores with minimum test score
